
1 FIND A NEED

3 CONSIDER QUANTITY AND QUALITY

Other serve ideas are designed to make a deep impact in the lives of a few people, like doing an extreme home makeover for a single mom and her kids. And some ideas are a combination of the two. Both are important and have a place in serving. Take some time to define your goal.



4 IS IT VOLUNTEER FRIENDLY?

Consider who you will invite to participate in your outreach and that their experience will be worthwhile. Make sure everyone gets a chance to add value, their time is honored, and that they want to serve again.
