HOW TO USE THIS GUIDE

We don't have to follow a specific formula to talk with God, but practicing different ways to pray can help us find deeper purpose and connection to Him through our prayer time.

This book is designed to give you prayer points we, as a church, will be praying over throughout the year. As a tool, we have assigned each prayer point to a day of the week to help bring focus to your prayer times throughout the week. Together, as a church, we will be following along with this schedule and invite you to follow along as well.

You will also find a monthly guide with verses to memorize, a daily scripture reading plan, and space to journal personal prayer points.

As you pray, focus on the points and give yourself time to intentionally hear from God. If your mind wanders, use the outline to restore your focus.

The goal of using this guide is not to add pressure or overwhelm you. It is simply to provide a tool for you to partner in prayer with us, and create a space for you to write down personal prayer points you are believing God for in 2024. This guide is intended to help your prayer life remain focused, effective, and enjoyable.

To make your prayer times even more meaningful, we encourage you to write notes, prayer requests, and play worship music. The important step is committing to regularly entering God's presence through prayer.

While prayer takes commitment and requires discipline to develop into a daily habit, we also want to remember that it's a "get to," and not a "have to." It's a privilege to be able to come to God in prayer.

PRAYER AS A LIFESTYLE

MARK 1:35

Very early in the morning, while it was still dark, Jesus got up, left the house and went off to a solitary place, where He prayed.

Prayer is most effective when it isn't something we do every now and then, but when it's a lifestyle we cultivate. To understand how to have a lifestyle of prayer, we can look at the example Jesus gave during His life on earth.

HAVE A CERTAIN TIME

Jesus got up early in the morning to spend time with His Father. Make a daily appointment with God – whether it's first thing in the morning, at lunch, or in the evening – and faithfully keep it.

HAVE A CERTAIN PLACE

Jesus had a specific place He went to pray. Having a designated place to pray helps us remove distractions, and frees us to worship and pray out loud.

HAVE A CERTAIN PLAN

When Jesus taught His disciples how to pray, He gave them a prayer outline. We call it "The Lord's Prayer." It can be found in Matthew 6. As we pray every day, our plans for our prayer time can vary. It may include worship music, Scripture reading, and quiet time to listen to God. It doesn't have to look the same, but it helps when we have a plan for connecting with God regularly.

Use the space provided on page 9 to write down your time with God plan by identifying a certain time, place, and plan.

WHAT IS FASTING?

MATTHEW 9:14-17

Then the disciples of John came to Him, saying, "Why do we and the Pharisees fast often, but Your disciples do not fast?" And Jesus said to them, "Can the friends of the bridegroom mourn as long as the bridegroom is with them? But the days will come when the bridegroom will be taken away from them, and then they will fast. No one puts a piece of unshrunk cloth on an old garment; for the patch pulls away from the garment, and the tear is made worse. Nor do they put new wine into old wineskins, or else the wineskins break, the wine is spilled, and the wineskins are ruined. But they put new wine into new wineskins, and both are preserved."

The goal of fasting is not just to do without food; it is to draw nearer to God. A biblical fast is restricting food for a spiritual purpose. Fasting is not just an exercise for the super spiritual, but it should be a periodic discipline in the life of every believer.

The constant demands and pressures of daily life on your mind, will, and emotions can weigh you down and cause you to lose focus, feel spiritually sluggish, and desensitized. Fasting hits the reset button for your soul and renews you from the inside out.

Fasting is a way for you to celebrate the goodness and mercy of God, and prepare your soul to expand and contain the fresh new purposes and work God desires to bring into your life.

CHOOSING THE RIGHT FAST

Your personal fast should present a level of challenge, but it is important to know your own body, know your options, and, most importantly, seek God in prayer. Then, follow what the Holy Spirit leads you to do.

NORMAL FAST

A normal fast is when only water is consumed. This would be the type practiced by Elijah (see 1 Kings 19:8) and Jesus (see Matthew 4). They abstained from food for 40 days.

PARTIAL FAST

A partial fast is when some foods are restricted. Two of the most common partial fasts are:

Juice Fast – Consuming vegetable juices, fruit juices, and water instead of solid food. Some include whey protein in their liquid plan as well. This is a popular and effective fast. Substituting liquids for one or two meals is also an alternative.

Daniel Fast – Is based on the fasting principles of the prophet in Daniel 1 and 10. Daniel 1 states that he ate only vegetables and water, and Daniel 10 states that he ate no rich (or choice) foods, as well as no meat or wine. The foundation of the Daniel fast is fruits and vegetables. The website daniel-fast.com is a good source of information about this fast.

Remember, the power of fasting has less to do with food and more to do with setting yourself apart for a specific period of time to focus more on the Lord, prayer, and worship.

HOW TO STUDY THE BIBLE

Each month we have identified a book of the Bible to study in your personal time with God. Throughout the month we encourage you to pace yourself as you read and study the Bible. A helpful tool to structure your time in Scripture is the SOAP Bible Study Method. This simple, yet in-depth, way of studying the Bible can have a profound impact on the way you hear from God by allowing His word to shape your life.

Items needed for each day: Bible, Pencil, and Journal

SOAP METHOD

SCRIPTURE - Which verse stood out to you?

Take your time reading and allow God to speak to you. Write out the verses that stood out to you by hand.

OBSERVATION – What is God saying to you?

Observe the passage carefully and note what you see. Note themes, relevant background information, literary devices, or questions you may have. Ask the Holy Spirit to teach you and reveal Jesus to you.

APPLICATION – How can you apply it today?

After observing the passage, determine the main message or truth of the passage. What action can you take today in light of this truth?

PRAYER – Ask God to help you use what you've learned.

Pray through what you have learned. This can be as simple as asking God to help you use this Scripture, or even a prayer for greater insight on what He may be revealing to you. Remember, prayer is a two-way conversation, so be sure to listen to what God has to say! Write it out.

HOW TO USE PRAYER POINTS

WEEKLY PRAYER GUIDE

In our Weekly Prayer Guide, we have strategically laid out the prayer points on specific days of the week to provide a structure that we will corporately pray through together throughout the year.

MONTHLY PRAYER GUIDE

Our Monthly Prayer Guide can be used in various ways, but our hope is by providing verses to memorize, a daily scripture reading plan, and creating space for you to journal personal prayer points, you will find yourself going deeper and seeking God more intentionally for yourself and others. The journaling space provided can be used to write down prayer requests and praises throughout the month to keep record of all God is doing.

2024 PRAYER POINTS

DECISIONS & BAPTISMS

Pray that the focus of our ministry environments will result in salvations, baptisms, and equipped lives. Pray for the Lord to empower you and use you to influence your homes, workplaces, schools, and community so we can be a light in a darkened world.

SMALL GROUPS

Pray for the small group leaders who are serving and ministering to the individuals and families of the church. They are investing great time and energy to see people connect with God and build spiritual family. We believe in making disciples and multiplying to reach the region, and Small Groups are the ministry environment best suited to accomplish this mission.

MISSIONAL IMPACT

Jesus invites all of us to join Him in reaching the world and living on mission. This mission starts in our hearts, works through our families, impacts our neighborhoods, affects our entire city, and then keeps spreading to the ends of the earth. At Grace Creek Church, there are many ways to live on mission through local outreaches, mission trips, and our Serve Team. We have great anticipation and expectancy for God to reach people with the Gospel.

DISCIPLESHIP

As we reach people and build lives, personal discipleship is the key to each person walking in all God has for them. Pray for more individuals to step out and lead small groups, more Serve Team members to pursue leadership roles, and individuals, like yourself, to find opportunities to make a disciple.



PRAYER

SCRIPTURES FOR PRAYER & CONFESSION

I WILL BE ANXIOUS FOR NOTHING, BUT IN PRAYER AND THANKSGIVING, I WILL PRESENT MY REQUEST.

PROVERBS 21:20 – The wise man saves for the future, but the foolish man spends whatever he gets.

EVERY KNEE SHOULD BOW AND EVERY TONGUE SHOULD CONFESS THAT JESUS CHRIST IS LORD.

PHILIPPIANS 2:10-11 – So that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth, and every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.

THE HOLY SPIRIT

SCRIPTURES FOR PRAYER & CONFESSION

THE HOLY SPIRIT LEADS ME INTO ALL TRUTH.

JOHN 16:13 – When the Spirit of truth comes, He will guide you into all the truth, for He will not speak on His own authority, but whatever He hears He will speak, and He will declare to you the things that are to come.

I AM LED BY THE SPIRIT AND AM NO LONGER UNDER THE LAW.

GALATIANS 5:18 – But if you are led by the Spirit, you are not under the law.

THE HOLY SPIRIT IS MY COMFORTER AND HELPER.

JOHN 16:7 – Nevertheless, I tell you the truth: it is to your advantage that I go away, for if I do not go away, the Helper will not come to you. But if I go, I will send Him to you.

MY BODY IS A TEMPLE OF THE HOLY SPIRIT.

1 CORINTHIANS 6:19 – Or do you not know that your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit within you, whom you have from God? You are not your own.

THE BAPTISM WITH THE HOLY SPIRIT GIVES ME POWER TO WITNESS.

ACTS 1:8 – But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you, and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth.

I WILL WALK IN THE SPIRIT AND NOT FULFILL THE LUST OF THE FLESH.

GALATIANS 5:16-17 – But I say, walk by the Spirit, and you will not gratify the desires of the flesh. For the desires of the flesh are against the Spirit, and the desires of the Spirit are against the flesh, for these are opposed to each other, to keep you from doing the things you want to do.

THE HOLY SPIRIT INTERCEDES FOR ME ACCORDING TO GOD'S WILL.

ROMANS 8:26-27 – Likewise the Spirit helps us in our weakness. For we do not know what to pray for as we ought, but the Spirit himself intercedes for us with groanings too deep for words. And He who searches hearts knows what is the mind of the Spirit, because the Spirit intercedes for the saints according to the will of God.

HEALING

SCRIPTURES FOR PRAYER & CONFESSION

JESUS CAN HEAL EVERY SICKNESS AND DISEASE AMONG US.
